The chorus is led by Florida Opera Theatre's Chorus Master and Music Director, Robin Andrew Stamper. Florida Opera Theatre is Orlando's young but growing professional opera company which opened its inaugural season last year with performances of Gian Carlo Menotti's The Medium and Gioachino Rossini's Il barbiere di Siviglia. The 2012-2013 season will include a three concert series of opera arias. A production of Puccini's Gianni Schicchi in December will be followed in January by Menotti's The Telephone plus A Musical Review of Ringing Proportions presented in collaboration with The Maitland Art and History Museum.
